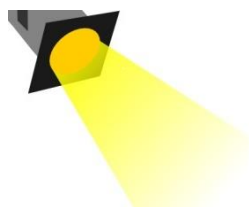

What Did I Miss Last Week at the May 29, Meeting?



Mike Dobesh, Assistant Fire Chief for the Richfield Fire Department guided Club members to learn CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) using "Rescue Annie" training manikins (see photo at right of Dick Swason practicing the technique). CPR is an emergency lifesaving procedure performed when the heart stops beating. Immediate CPR can double or triple chances of survival after cardiac arrest. It is



important in by keeping the blood flow active – even partially – extending the opportunity for a successful resuscitation once trained medical staff arrive on site.
