Rich talked about the sequence at which air bags go off in event of an impact. Seat belt retractors will deploy when a force of 18 MPH is reached. Next in line is the window bags, then the curtain air bags over the windows, and finally the driver air bag. ***Elapsed time between these events is almost impossible to tell!***

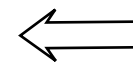
