with a 15 member

board of directors. They are responsible
for all airports in a 35 mile radius of
downtown Minneapolis. They have a
staff of 600, with their own police, fire,
911 dispatch, etc.

MSP is the 16th busiest airport in
America, with over 37 million
passengers each year, & has 155 direct
routes out of the airport.

MSP has a 10.1 Billion dollar impact on
our community. They have run the most
extensive noise mitigation program in
the entire USA.

Major building & remodeling is
underway of ticketing & baggage area.
A new 300 room hotel is scheduled for
completion in 2018.
