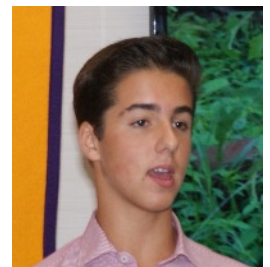

Their organization gives goats to people
in Uganda to help them create a micro
business - which in turn will pay for their
education.

A goat cost \$125. each. Thus far, they
have donated over 500 goats. They use
a hybrid which is more resistant to
disease. Most are females in order to
facilitate reproduction. One male to a
flock is usual.
